**GOING INTO HOSPITAL?** If you wish to see a Catholic Chaplain during your stay in hospital, you need to ask the hospital staff to contact him. There is always a priest on call for emergencies, but staff will not page the priest unless asked by patients or families. Patient's Religious Declaration, which a person when admitted to hospital, or a relative/friend, should give to ward-staff to ensure they can see a Catholic Chaplain. This can also be achieved through a verbal-request to staff. This is necessary due to the way confidentiality rules are applied in most hospitals.

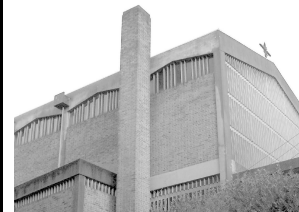

### Safeguarding Training

This is to inform that additional dates have been added to the Safeguarding Training Calendar, giving more opportunities to attend Safeguarding Induction Part 1 locally. This Safeguarding Induction is aimed to new volunteers and all those existing volunteers who still need to complete this training by the deadline of 31st October 2018 (as per our previous memos dated 9th May, 8th August and 19th September 2018).
