SAFEGUARDING INDUCTION PART 1 TRAINING:

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

Safeguarding Induction Part 1 is mandatory for parish volunteers who work with children/ protected adults on a regular basis. New parish volunteers who intend to work with children and/or vulnerable adults on a regular basis must attend before taking up their role. Existing parish volunteers who work with children and/or vulnerable adults on a regular basis and who have NOT previously attended Safeguarding training provided by the Catholic Church must attend.

Other volunteers (who do not work with children/protected adults on a regular basis) are very welcome too and can also attend (but the training is not mandatory for them).

AIMS OF THE TRAINING

TO INTRODUCE PARISH VOLUNTEERS TO:

The concept of Safeguarding and its implications in a church context
The responsibilities of the Parish Volunteer and the Parish Safeguarding Co-ordinator

A basic understanding of recognising, responding and reporting abuse/concerns

Practical provisions for working safely with children/adults at risk
