HOW 'GREEN' IS OUR PARISH?

At the Parish Pastoral Council on Thursday we took some time to reflect on the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation which takes place on September 1. The effects of climate change and other threats to the world in which we live is something we all are increasingly aware of. The question then is for us not just as individuals but as members of the parish community. Some things to think about to start with: Do you really need to bring your car to Mass every weekend, and if you do, could you possibly car share? Can we make sure that in the house, church and hall all efforts can be made to recycle, reuse and reduce as much as possible? For example, what happens to this bulletin when you've read it? Can we move away from all single use plastic items in the parish?

ADULT FAITH FORMATION.

We are planning on presenting a six week course "The Eucharist in Scripture." A series of video talks by Scott Hahn, author of *At the Lamb's Supper* and *Rome, Sweet Home*. He will walk us through the roots of the Blessed Sacrament. Where we find the institution of the Eucharist in Scripture, what we actually believe is happening at Mass, and why the Eucharist was at the centre of the faith of the early Christians. The proposal is to run this series at two different times, one afternoon (Thursday?) and one evening (Tuesday?) to try to suit as many people as possible. More information to follow, but we'd be interested to get an idea of how many participant books to order. The materials aren't out yet, so it may be later into the autumn before we can get hold of it.
